

Guidelines for Abstract Submission:

High-quality, original research articles that meet the eligibility criteria outlined below will be selected for poster presentation by a robust scientific committee:

1. **Mandatory Registration:** Registration for the CME is a prerequisite for presenting a poster.
2. **Abstract Requirements:**
 - The abstract should be between **250–300 words**, excluding the title, keywords, and references.
 - It must be structured under the following headings:
 - **Background**
 - **Aims and Objectives**
 - **Materials and Methods**
 - **Results**
 - **Conclusion**
 - **Keywords**
3. **Formatting Specifications:**
 - Line spacing: **1.5**
 - Font: **Times New Roman**, size **12-point**
4. **Author Affiliations:**
 - Affiliations must be indicated using **superscript Arabic numerals** placed at the end of each author's surname.
5. **Authorship:**
 - All co-authors must be listed in accordance with their contributions to the work.
6. **Poster Limitation:**
 - A maximum of **one poster per presenter** will be accepted.
7. **Submission Deadline:**
 - The last date for abstract submission is **16 August 2025**.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation

1. **Format:**
 - All posters must be submitted in **physical format only** (HD flex sheets).
2. **Size and Orientation:**
 - Poster dimensions must be **51" × 38" inches**, in **portrait orientation**.
 - Content layout should follow a **logical and sequential order**.
3. **Header Content:**
 - The **title** should be engaging and clearly visible.
 - The **presenting author's name** must be **bolded and underlined**, accompanied by their **departmental and institutional affiliation**.
4. **Display Timing:**
 - All posters must be **set up before the session begins** and remain displayed **throughout the session**.
5. **Presentation Time:**
 - Each presenter will have **10 minutes**:
 - **6–7 minutes** for the presentation
 - **2–3 minutes** for evaluation and discussion with the judges
6. **Post-Session Requirement:**
 - Posters and materials must be **removed immediately after the session**, and the area should be **left clean**.
7. **Awards:**
 - The **top three posters** will be selected for **awards**.

Tips for Effective Poster Presentation

1. Posters are meant to **initiate discussion**, not serve as lengthy presentations.
 - Keep **text minimal**, focus on **visual elements**, and ensure a **logical flow** of ideas.
2. Represent data using **graphs or tables** wherever possible.
 - **Avoid repetition** of information.
3. Use **high-resolution photographs**, if applicable.
4. The use of **typewritten sheets** or printed **PowerPoint slides** as posters is **strictly prohibited** and will lead to **rejection**.
5. Maintain **consistent margins, line spacing, font style, color schemes, and border thickness** for a professional appearance.
6. Ensure **legibility**:
 - Poster **title** should be readable from **20 feet** away.
 - Body text should be clearly visible from **6 feet** away.
7. Posters that have been **previously published** or **presented at other CMEs or conferences** will **not be accepted**.
